

CDRSS 2.0 TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

The following is important information regarding the upgraded CDRSS system (CDRSS 2.0):

- Current and new users are required to attend an in-person onsite training **OR** participate in an online webinar in order to gain access to CDRSS 2.0.
 - In-person onsite trainings are available at select training locations
 - Online webinar is prerecorded and followed by a live Q&A session.
- There are no costs or fees to participate.
- **Google Chrome is preferred for CDRSS 2.0. Functionalities will work in IE, Microsoft Edge or Firefox however it needs more testing to resolve page display issues. If Chrome is not set up on your computer, please contact technical support within your organization.**
