

CDRSS 2.0 TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES

The following is important information regarding the upgraded CDRSS system (CDRSS 2.0):

- Current users (old system) are required to attend an in-person onsite training **OR** participate in an online webinar in order to gain access to CDRSS 2.0.
 - In-person onsite trainings are available at select training locations
 - Online webinar is prerecorded and followed by a live Q&A session.
- There are no costs or fees to participate.
- **Google Chrome is required to access CDRSS 2.0. If Chrome is not set up on your computer, please request IT support in your organization.**
